EL EVENTO

The Peruvian Cycling Federation is pleased to invite riders of your country to participate in the Pan American Track Elite Championship, which grants points to the UCI track ranking to take place from June 23rd to June 29th, 2021 in the Velodrome of the National Sports Village (VIDENA).

CITY: LIMA - PERU



Lima is the capital city of the Republic of Peru. It is located on the central coast of the country, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, reaching an altitude of 101 meters above sea level. The coastline of Lima is cloudy almost all year round in a strip that covers up to 15 meters of beaches, depriving it of solar radiation. The sun appears at the end of spring and in summer, the increase in heat coincides with the rise of the rivers due to the Andean rains. The city of Lima, located on the coastline, has an arid and semi-warm climate with an average annual maximum temperature of 21.97°C (71.4°F) and a minimum of 17°C (62.7°F).

Lima's tourist attractions do not go unnoticed to travelers visiting South America. The capital of the country mixes the traditional with the modern. Lima has archaeological sites, churches, squares and buildings to offer with architecture, parks and restaurants to admire.

Lima is the only South American capital that has access to the Pacific Ocean. Its beaches of big waves are a paradise for surfers and its broad boardwalks offer spaces to enjoy the views and the sea breeze.

CURRENCY

NATIONAL CURRENCY: The national currency is the SOL and its equivalent to one U.S. dollar is 3.65 soles.

STANDARD VOLTAGE AND PLUG

The electrical voltage is 220 Volts. Adopted standard plugs in Peru are type A, B and C.

LODGING:

The Organization of the Pan American Track Elite Championship, will provide the lodging and food and breakfast from June 23rd to June 29th. The arrival of teams may be on June 23rd and 24th, for a maximum of 22 persons, including 10 male athletes, 8 female athletes and 4 managers.

TRANSPORTATION:

The organization has arranged transportation services from airport-hotel-airport. Each National Federation will have until **May 8th** of this year to confirm their numerical participation and until **May 22nd** to send the registration in the corresponding formats, as well as their arrival itineraries for the coordination of the reception of teams and to be able to provide them with the support of transportation and transfer to the main hotel, foreseen by the Organization. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for the arrival or transportation of those national federations that do not send the information of their itineraries, number of members of the delegation and number of bicycles or equipment they bring. Transportation will be provided to and from the competition site to the hotel or place of lodging.

COVID-19 HEALTH PROTOCOLS:

Delegations should be aware that Covid-19 pandemic safety measures will be implemented. These security measures will be those recommended by the UCI and those indicated by the Peruvian government. Among them are:

Peruvian Government Health Protocols indicate that all passengers entering the country by airport or seaport must meet the following requirements:

1. Molecular test for COVID 19 with a negative result no more than 72 hours before entering the country. Said result must be brought in hard copy and digital copy.
2. Vaccination certificate if the athlete, coach, delegate or support staff has the vaccine. Bring a printed copy and digital copy of the vaccination certificate.
3. For the entrance to the VIDENA lodging facilities and the Lodge, please bring additional printed copies of the documents requested above.
4. Bring a medical certificate issued by a health professional authorized by the national federation or Olympic committee of your country.

Inside the sports bubble there are some instructions to be carried out.

1. At the moment of entering the VIDENA Lodge, it is not allowed to leave the premises of the property.
2. The organization will have personnel assigned to take 1 delegate per country to go out of the bubble to buy some food. Only 1 delegate per country will be allowed to leave.
3. Medical personnel will be available at all times.

Daily forms will be filled out on the health status of all members of each Delegation.

REGISTRATION:

Registration will only be effective with the official registration form sent for such purpose before **May 1st** and sent to the Organizing Committee to atajut@fedepesi.pe and panaci@enet.cu. Send photos for the credentials together with the Registration Form. Identify them with your Passport number. (See Annex 1 for recommendations)

GROUP OF COMMISAIRE:

One (1) UCI International Commissaire appointed by the International Cycling Union (UCI).

Four (4) UCI International or UCI National Elite Commissaires appointed by the Pan American Cycling Confederation (COPACI).

The Peruvian Cycling Sports Federation (FDPC) shall appoint the 12 Commissaires for the composition of the Group of Commissaires.

ANT-IDOPING CONTROL:

One (1) anti-doping inspector will be designated by the International Cycling Union (UCI). It shall be carried out according to the current regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI).

RULES:

The competition shall be conducted in accordance with the regulations of the International Cycling Union with the program drawn up by COPACI.

APPENDIX 1

PHOTO RECOMMENDATIONS

All the photos must meet the requirements reported in the guide:

The person must be easily identifiable in the photo.

The photo must be recent (taken within the last six months) and be a faithful photo of the applicant.

The facial expression must be neutral, with the mouth closed.

Eyes should be open and clearly visible

The face should occupy 70% to 80% of the photo.

Face and shoulders should be centered in the photo and facing the camera.

The photo should show a full frontal view of the head with both sides of the face clear.

There should be no shadows or reflections from the flash on the face and head.

Eyeglasses are not allowed in the photo.

Hats and head coverings are only allowed for medical or religious reasons as long as the facial features are fully visible.

Must be in color

The background of the photo must be plain white.

All images must be submitted in digital format (.jpg, .jpeg, .gif, .png, .bmp)

The file size of the photo must be between 50kb and 100kb

The size of the photo should be 4cm wide by 5cm high.

Recommended resolution should be approximately 300 DPI
