CIUDAD: CUSCO - PERÚ



Cusco is a city in southeastern Peru located on the eastern slopes of the Andes, in the basin of the Huatanay River, a tributary of the Vilcanota. It is the capital of the department of Cusco and, in addition, as declared in the Peruvian Constitution, is the "historical capital" of the country.

It was formerly the capital of the Inca Empire and one of the most important cities of the viceroyalty of Peru. During the viceroyalty times, under the sovereignty of the Spanish crown, several churches, universities, palaces and baroque and neoclassical squares were built. These constructions are the attractions that make the city the main tourist destination in the country. It was declared a National Historic Monument in 1972 and a World Heritage Site in 1983 by UNESCO. And it is often called, due to the large number of monuments it has, the «Rome of America».



Huarocondo District is one of nine comprising the province of Anta.

## CURRENCY

NATIONAL CURRENCY: The national currency is the SOL and its equivalent to one U.S. dollar is 3.8 soles.

## STANDARD VOLTAGE AND PLUG

The electrical voltage is 220 Volts. Adopted standard plugs in Peru are type A, B and C.



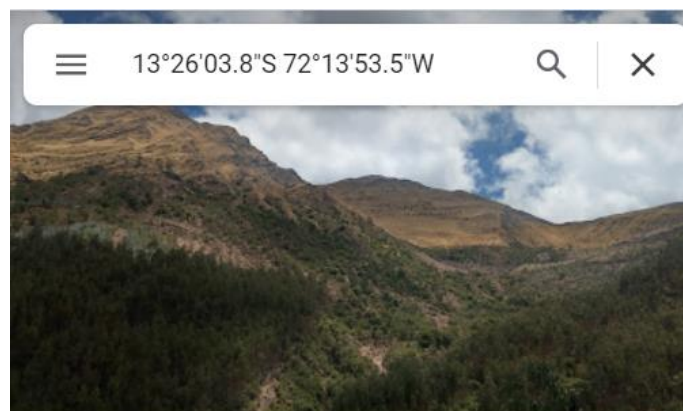


### Location of the Track:

The track is located in Ecopark Rahuanki, 7 minutes from Huarucondo, between Cusco the Valle Sagrado, 20 minutes from Anta. Participants can stay in Anta, Huarucondo or El Valle Sagrado. Regular public transportation from Anta to Huarucondo will be made available.

## Track details

**Start:** 4120 msnm

**Finish line:** 3430 msnm

**Length:** 3.2 Km

**Ascend time in car from the start:** 30 minutes approx.,

**Uphill track:** One lane Trocha carrozable.

The following facilities will be located around the Finish line:

- Commercial tents area (sponsors, exhibitors, bicycle stores, etc.) In this area you can rent spaces in 3x3 meter modules to show and sell your products.
- Food area: Area where food will be sold to riders and the public at large.
- Rider's area: Only riders and their delegates will have access to the riders' tent area. All teams will have a covered space of at least 3 x 3 meters at their disposal in the "Team Area".  
IMPORTANT: Due to the layout of the terrain and grandstands, it will not be possible to bring or set up private tents.
- General stands: On training days admission is free. On competition days there will be a cost to be determined at a later date.

## PARTICIPANTS

All riders licensed by COPACI national federation members, and these alone, may take part in continental championship events. There is no maximum number of participating riders for any Federation.

## LODGING AND FOOD:

The Organizer will not provide lodging or food to the riders of any Federation.

## TRANSPORTATION:

Airport - Hotel - Airport transportation will be the responsibility of each Delegation. On race and training days, there will be support transportation to go up to the start for those who do not have their own transportation, which will be available according to schedules to be established later.

The deadline for **ordinary registrations** is **September 31, 2023**. **Late registrations will be received until October 7th.**

All riders must present, at the time of registration upon confirmation, their updated licenses issued by their corresponding National Federation.

All athletes must provide proof of their **international medical insurance**. The delegates will be responsible for presenting the documentation at the time of registration.

**WITHDRAWAL OF ATHLETES:** If an athlete is unable to participate in the competition due to health problems or any other reason, his\her withdrawal and the respective refund of the money will be made until Friday, **October 6**. After this date, no withdrawals will be accepted and no refunds will be made. Those delegations that have not yet paid their registrations must pay the total number of athletes registered in their delegation at the time of registration.
