In 2025, the Pan American BMX Freestyle Championships Lima 2025 will be organized and held in the city of Lima, Peru, on September 13 and 14, 2025.

CITY: LIMA - PERÚ



Lima is the capital city of the Republic of Peru. It is located on the central coast of the country, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, and sits at an altitude of 101 meters above sea level. Lima's coastline is often cloudy most of the year, in a strip up to 15 meters from the beaches, limiting sun exposure. The sun emerges at the end of spring and in summer, as heat increases and river levels rise due to Andean rains. Lima has an arid and semi-warm climate, with an average annual high temperature of 21.97°C (71.4°F) and a low of 17°C (62.7°F).

Tourist attractions in Lima don't go unnoticed by travelers visiting South America. The capital blends tradition and modernity, offering archaeological sites, churches, squares, architecturally admirable buildings, parks, and restaurants.

Lima is the only South American capital with direct access to the Pacific Ocean. Its beaches with large waves are a paradise for surfers, and its long boardwalks offer ideal spaces to enjoy the sea views and breeze.

CURRENCY

National Currency: The national currency is the Sol (PEN). Its approximate exchange rate is 3.80 soles per US dollar.



LOCATION OF THE TRACK

The track is located in the district of San Miguel in Lima, within the Costa Verde beach circuit. It is about 15 minutes from Miraflores or San Isidro. Accommodations can be found in San Isidro, Miraflores, or the more affordable and nearby San Miguel. The circuit is accessed via the Bajada Bertolotto in San Miguel. There is no public transportation directly to the circuit.






THE TRACK



Our track was built for the Pan American Games Lima 2019 in accordance with UCI regulations.



FACILITIES AT THE VENUE

- **Commercial Area:** Stands for sponsors, exhibitors, and bike shops. Spaces (3x3 meters) can be rented for displaying and selling products.
- **Food Area:** Pre-packaged food will be sold for athletes and the general public. Pre-ordered menus will be available for delegations.
- **Athlete Area:** Access only for athletes and their delegates. Each team will have a covered 3x3 meter space with a table and 4 chairs in the "Team Area."

⚠️ IMPORTANT: Due to terrain and bleacher arrangement, personal tents or canopies will not be allowed.

- **General Bleachers:** Free access during training days. Entry fee (TBD) during competition days; for accompanying persons only.
- **VIP Bleachers:** For coaches, delegates, and officials. Entry restricted during training; entry fee (TBD) for competition days.

PARTICIPANTS

All riders with licenses issued by COPACI member National Federations may participate. The maximum number of riders per federation is equal for all.

For BMX Freestyle Park:

If a federation brings more than 3 riders per gender, an elimination round will be held. All delegations participate, but only the top 3 riders per nation and gender (based on points) will advance to qualification.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition format will follow the attached chart. Each run will last 1 minute, during which riders perform various tricks that are judged based on the level of difficulty and quality of execution throughout their run. In the elimination round (if applicable), riders will have 2 runs, and the average of both runs will determine who advances to the qualification stage. Each heat consists of two runs.

Following the elimination round, two qualification heats will be held the next day. The result will be the average score of both heats, and riders will then advance to the semifinals or finals according to the attached chart. In these stages, the highest score will be taken into account either for advancing to the next stage or for the final result.

The format of the QUALIFICATION stage follows the attached chart in accordance with UCI regulations: The grouping of phases and heats for a category will depend on the number of registered participants. The following table explains the groupings.

| More than 31 entries | 3 phases: Qualification x 1 Semi-final x 1 Final x 1 | Top 24 in Qualification advance to Semi-final Top 12 in Semi-final advance to Final | Qualification: as below 4 heats of 6 in Semi-final 2 heats of 6 in Final |

A heat will be a group consisting of 4 to 6 riders.

In the case of 7 registered riders, the heat will consist of 7 riders.

The BMX Freestyle competition categories for this Continental Championship are:

- **Elite Men:** From 15 years old
- **Elite Women:** From 15 years old

REGISTRATION

Registrations must be submitted using the form provided by the organization and through the National Federations, by sending an email to presidencia@fedepeci.pe with a copy to atajut@fedepeci.pe. The form and instructions for filling it out can be downloaded from www.fedepeci.pe.

REGISTRATION IS FREE

The deadline for regular registrations is September 1, 2025. Late registrations will be accepted until September 10.

Riders must present valid licenses issued by their respective National Federation at the time of registration confirmation.

All athletes must provide proof of international medical insurance. Team delegates will be responsible for submitting the required documentation when formalizing their registrations.

WITHDRAWAL OF ATHLETES: If an athlete is unable to participate in the competition due to health issues or any other reason, their withdrawal will only be accepted until September 10. After this date, no athlete withdrawals will be accepted. Delegations must formalize their registrations.

AWARDS.-

Trophies for 1st to 3rd place in each category based on final scores.

MEDICAL ATTENTION.-

- Primary care on the track.
- Transfer to the official clinic or another facility at no cost.
- The cost of medical care at the official clinic or elsewhere is the responsibility of the rider or their Federation (UCI license insurance).
- The Peruvian Cycling Sports Federation, the event organizers, and any member of the organization are not responsible for any medical expenses incurred outside the track.
