In 2025, the Pan American BMX Flatland Championship Lima 2025 will be held in the city of Lima, Peru on September 13 and 14.

CITY: LIMA - PERÚ



Lima is the capital city of the Republic of Peru. It is located on the central coast of the country, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, at an altitude of 101 meters above sea level. The coastal area of Lima is cloud-covered for most of the year, blocking direct sunlight. The sun appears at the end of spring and during summer, coinciding with warmer temperatures and increased river flow due to rainfall in the Andes. Lima's climate is arid and semi-warm, with an average maximum temperature of 21.97°C (71.4°F) and a minimum of 17°C (62.7°F).

Lima offers a blend of tradition and modernity, with archaeological sites, churches, plazas, impressive architecture, parks, and renowned restaurants. It is the only South American capital city with direct access to the Pacific Ocean, making it a paradise for surfers and a scenic location for enjoying ocean views and the coastal breeze.

CURRENCY

National Currency: The national currency is the Peruvian Sol (PEN). The approximate exchange rate is 3.7 Soles per US Dollar.

ELECTRICAL VOLTAGE AND OUTLETS

The electrical voltage in Peru is 220 Volts. Plug types A, B, and C are used.

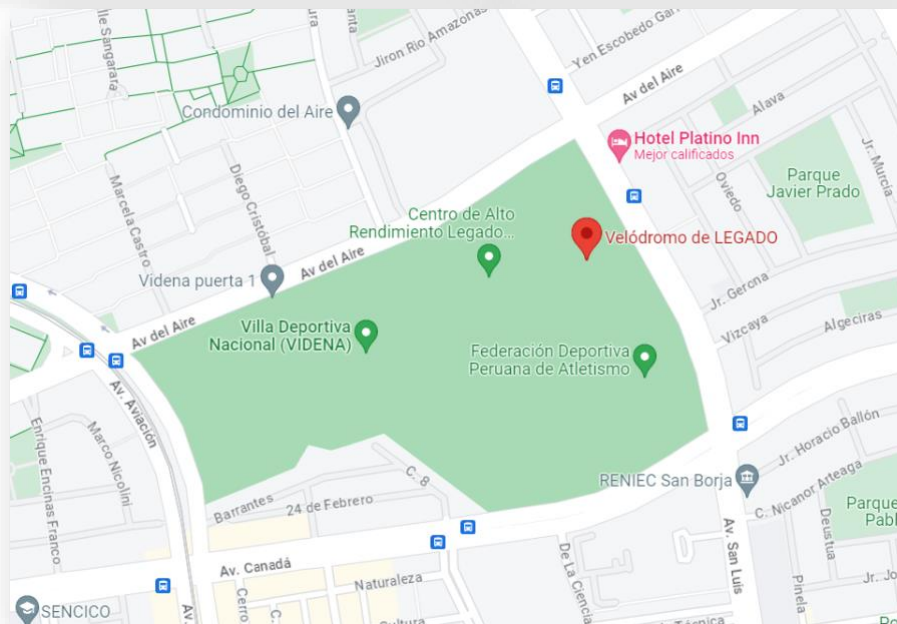


VENUE LOCATION

Track Location:

Velodrome at VIDENA, Av. San Luis 1221, Cercado de Lima 15021.

Entry through Gate 7 of VIDENA



ACCOMMODATION:

The organization will not provide lodging, but advance registration may allow access to accommodation at the VIDENA Dormitory, located 150 meters from the Velodrome. The cost is \$15 USD per person per day, based on quadruple rooms. Reservations can be made until August 14.

TRANSPORTATION:

The organization will not provide any transportation services.

PARTICIPANTS

Only licensed riders from COPACI-affiliated national federations are allowed to compete. The maximum number of riders per federation is the same for all countries.

For BMX Freestyle Flat, if a federation enters more than three riders per gender, an elimination round will be held. All delegations will participate, and for those with more than three riders, only the top 3 riders per gender and nation with the highest scores in the elimination round will move on to the qualification round.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition format is shown in the attached chart. Each run will be 3 minutes long, during which riders will perform various tricks. These are scored based on difficulty and execution.

In the elimination round (if necessary), riders perform one run, and their score determines who advances to the qualification round.

After the elimination round, the following day will feature the remaining phases according to the number of competitors. If no country has more than three riders, the elimination round will be omitted. Each phase consists of a single run per rider. Advancement to the next phase will depend on their score and the number of participants.

- **Elite Men:** Male riders aged 15 and older
- **Elite Women:** Female riders aged 15 and older

REGISTRATION

Registrations must be submitted through national federations using the form provided by the organizers.

REGISTRATION IS FREE

- **Ordinary registration deadline:** September 1, 2025
- **Late registration deadline:** September 10, 2025

Upon confirmation of registration, riders must present updated licenses issued by their national federation.

All athletes must provide proof of international medical insurance. Team delegates are responsible for submitting documentation.

WITHDRAWAL OF ATHLETES: If an athlete is unable to participate in the competition due to health issues or any other reason, their withdrawal will only be accepted until September 10. After this date, no athlete withdrawals will be accepted. Delegations must formalize their registrations.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to **1st to 3rd place** based on final scores, for both categories.

MEDICAL ATTENTION

- Primary medical care will be available at the track.
- Free transport to the official or alternative clinic.
- Treatment costs are covered by the rider or their federation (UCI license insurance).
- The FDPC and event organizers are not liable for off-site medical expenses.
