The Peruvian Cycling Sports Federation is pleased to invite the riders from your country to participate in the American Series MTB DHI Lima 2025, which will be held from October 16 to 19, 2025, at the Amancay Circuit, in the district of Pachacamac.

CITY: LIMA - PERÚ



Lima is the capital city of the Republic of Peru. It is located on the central coast of the country, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, and sits at an altitude of 101 meters above sea level. Lima's coastline is often cloudy most of the year, in a strip up to 15 meters from the beaches, limiting sun exposure. The sun emerges at the end of spring and in summer, as heat increases and river levels rise due to Andean rains. Lima has an arid and semi-warm climate, with an average annual high temperature of 21.97°C (71.4°F) and a low of 17°C (62.7°F).

Tourist attractions in Lima don't go unnoticed by travelers visiting South America. The capital blends tradition and modernity, offering archaeological sites, churches, squares, architecturally admirable buildings, parks, and restaurants.

Lima is the only South American capital with direct access to the Pacific Ocean. Its beaches with large waves are a paradise for surfers, and its long boardwalks offer ideal spaces to enjoy the sea views and breeze.

THE EVENT

This TECHNICAL GUIDE covers the rules and procedures relevant to the OFFICIAL or PRO categories regulated by the UCI (Junior and Elite for both genders), as well as the PROMOTIONAL or AMATEUR categories (Novice, Sub 8, Sub 14, Master A, Master B, Master C, Hardtail, Enduro, E-bikes, Junior Promotional, Women's Promotional, and Senior).

The American Series MTB DHI Lima 2025 is a mountain bike competition in the Downhill individual discipline, to be held from October 16 to 19, 2025, at the Amancay Circuit, in the District of Pachacamac, Province of Lima.

The American Series MTB DHI Lima 2025 is a UCI CLASS CS (Continental Series) EVENT, organized by the Peruvian Cycling Sports Federation, and is endorsed by the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and the Pan American Cycling Confederation (COPACI). It also serves as the fourth round of the American Continental Series in the DH discipline.

Accordingly, by registering for this event, athletes agree to comply with and be subject to the rules and procedures described in this TECHNICAL GUIDE, the regulations of the FDPC, as well as those of the UCI and COPACI, and may not claim ignorance of them at any time.

The competition will be held in accordance with the regulations of the Union Cycliste Internationale and the program established by COPACI.

FROM THE COMPETITION:

a. QUALIFICATION AND FINAL

The competition consists of 2 runs.

- **The qualification run:** Will determine the starting order of the riders for the final run, with participants starting from the slowest to the fastest. The starting order for the qualification run will be based on the current UCI ranking or the 2024 National DH ranking.
- **The final run:** Will determine the winner of each category. The winner will be the competitor who completes the run in the shortest time.

b. AGE

The minimum age to compete in the UCI categories is 17 years, while for the promotional categories the minimum age required is 8 years. The competition age is the age reached as of December 31, 2025.

c. BICYCLE

The bicycle required to participate in the Peruvian National Downhill Championship must be a dual-suspension bike (front and rear). Currently, most brands use 29-inch wheels; however, bicycles with two different wheel diameters will also be allowed. In this race, the use of hardtail bikes and E-bikes will also be permitted, with a promotional category established for each.

COMPETITION EQUIPMENT:

a. EQUIPMENT: Riders are required to have adequate protection. A full-face helmet with visor, gloves, and knee pads are mandatory for competition.

Helmets other than full-face are not permitted.

Handlebar ends or extensions are not allowed on bicycles.

The bicycle must display the number plate on the front.

The rider must wear and fasten the helmet during every run, whether it is training, qualification, or final.

b. CLOTHING: Every rider must present themselves at the start line properly uniformed, wearing a long-sleeve jersey, long pants, or short pants with knee and shin protection. This attire is mandatory for both training and races. The use of a full-face helmet with visor is mandatory, and it must be securely fastened. In addition, gloves, knee pads, and elbow pads are required.

The use of headphones or similar devices is not permitted. The use of short-sleeve or sleeveless shirts is also not allowed.

REGISTRATION:

Registration will only be accepted using the official registration form provided for this purpose, which must be submitted before October 15TH, 2025 and sent to the Organizing Committee at atajut@fedepeci.pe with a copy to presidencia@fedepeci.pe.

The organizers reserve the right to close a specific PROMOTIONAL or AMATEUR category if the number of registered athletes does not reach a minimum of 5 participants. In such cases, athletes will be grouped into the next higher category, or into a single category.

REGISTRATION FEE:

Registration for all UCI categories is **USD\$100 (One Hundred and 00/100 US Dollars)**, while for Promotional categories it is **USD\$70.00 (Seventy and 00/100 US Dollars)**, which must be made no later than October 15, 2025.

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

Event registration must be completed no later than October 14th, 2025, at 23:59 hours, attaching registration form. Payment can be made on October 15th, 2025 as last day.

RACE NUMBER DISTRIBUTION:

Race numbers (number plates for bicycles) will be distributed on Friday, October 17, from 8:00 to 16:00 hours at the circuit. The distribution will take place at the bottom of the track, in the finish area, near the finish line.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

All categories will use a two-run format. The first run will consist of a qualification run to determine the starting order for the final run. The qualification run will take place on Saturday, October 18, at 11:15 hours. The starting order for the qualification run will be determined, from highest ranked to lowest ranked, using the UCI ranking and the national Downhill ranking valid as of December 2024. For non-ranked athletes, "expert judgment" and a draw will be applied.

For the final run, scheduled for Sunday, October 19, at 11:15 hours, the starting order will be established according to the results of the qualification run, with each category starting from the lowest ranked to the highest ranked rider, in other words, with a reversed grid.

The winner of each category in the American Series MTB DHI Lima 2025 will be the athlete who achieves the shortest time in the final run.

CONTROLLED TRAINING BY GROUPS:

Controlled training will take place on Friday, October 17th, from 8:00 to 16:00 hours. On Saturday, October 18th, and Sunday, October 19th, training will be from 7:30 to 10:30 hours. For training, bicycles must carry the number plate (race number) and be in good condition; riders must also wear the required clothing and protective equipment.

Training will be carried out in two groups, formed as follows:

GROUP A: JUNIOR WOMEN, ELITE WOMEN, JUNIOR MEN, ELITE MEN, PRE CADET, MASTER A, MASTER B, MASTER C.

GROUP B: NOVICE, SCHOOL, CHILDRENS, JUNIOR PROMOTIONAL, PROMOTIONAL CADETS, HARDELL, ENDURO, E-BIKES.

RIDER'S MEETING:

A Rider's/Delegates' Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 16th, 2025 at 18:00, which will be held virtually. Any other information will be communicated in a timely manner.


TRACK

The Amancay Sanctuary is located in the district of Pachacamac, Province of Lima, Department of Lima, Peru.

The Amancay Sanctuary is situated between the districts of Lurín and Pachacamac, just one hour from the city of Lima. From the Villa Chorrillos toll station, it takes approximately 41 minutes to reach the entrance of the Amancay Sanctuary (a map from the Villa Chorrillos toll station is attached).


The Sanctuary combines sport with conservation: in addition to being a sports center, it is also a protected area for the Amancay flower, the flora and fauna of the coastal hills, and archaeological sites. Its geography—with hills, slopes, rocks, and the typical vegetation of the coastal hills—makes it ideal for downhill mountain biking.

The downhill circuit includes natural trails, technical obstacles, tight turns, short climbs, jumps (step-downs and drops), berms, and more. These elements provide continuous routes with a high level of technical challenge.
